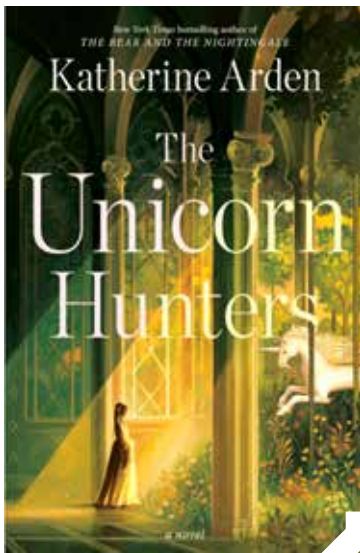

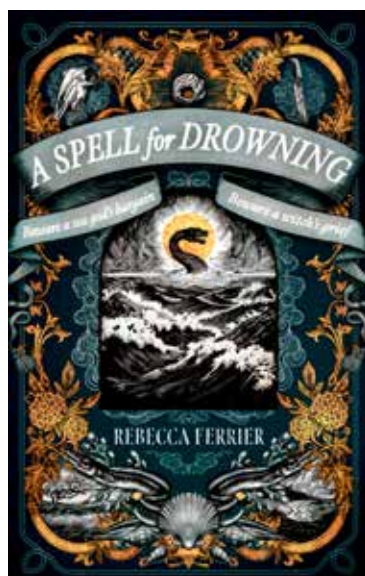
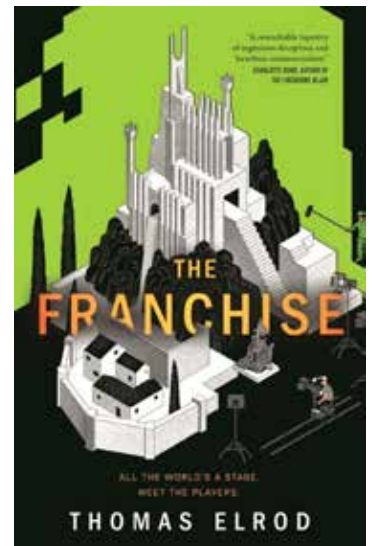
**The Franchise** by Thomas Elrod

Equal parts epic adventure, satire, and philosophical exploration, this novel questions power, free will, and the stories that shape our lives. Both entertaining and thought-provoking.

**A Spell for Drowning** by Rebecca Ferrier

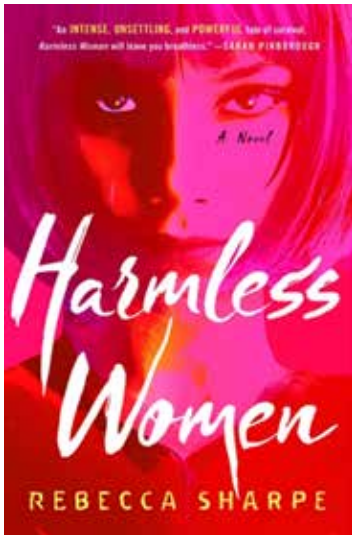

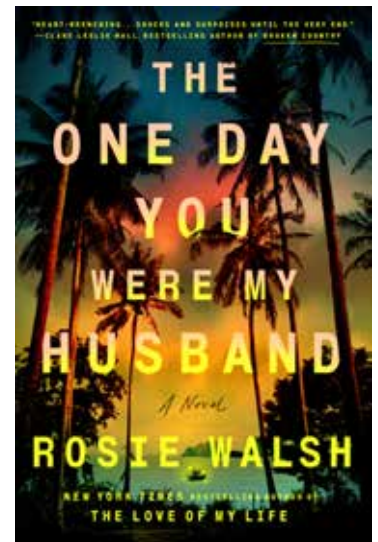
**The One Day You Were My Husband** by Rosie Walsh
